



**Each year we award merit scholarships of \$1,000.00 each to five graduating high school seniors.**

Please review the requirements for each Safeway Federal Credit Union scholarship applicant:

- You must be a member of the Safeway Federal Credit Union.
- You must be a senior in an accredited high school.
- Your accumulative high school grade point average “gpa” must be at least 3.25 and you must include a copy of your school’s grade transcript.
- You must include a copy of your SAT and/or ACT test scores – if you have them.  
If you don’t have them, please comment.
- You must submit a list of extracurricular activities.
- You must submit an essay (not more than 200 words) on your future goals and plans.
- You must submit two letters of recommendation- one from a high school faculty member and one from someone who knows you well (an employer, neighbor, etc.).
- Your application must be received at Safeway Federal Credit Union, 529 East North Foothills Drive, Spokane, WA 99207 by December 16th.

Your application will be kept confidential within the Credit Union’s scholarship committee. The committee consists of at least two members of the Credit Union’s board of directors and one Credit Union employee. Your application will not be returned. The decisions of the Credit Union’s scholarship committee are final.

The scholarships will be awarded at the annual meeting of the Credit Union in February. Credit Union employees and officers are not eligible to apply nor are their immediate family members.
